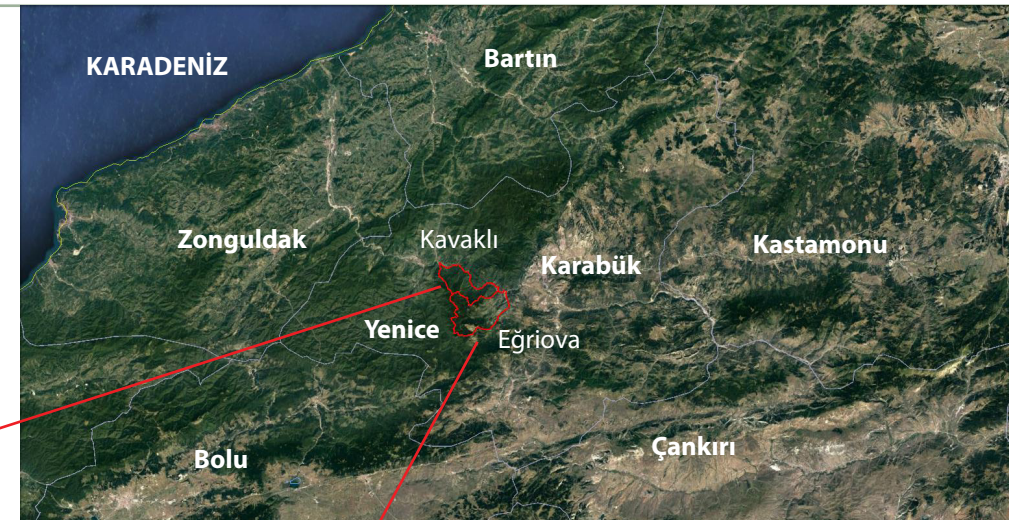

## Kavaklı

The total area of Kavaklı forest district is 4644,1 ha of which 95,8 % is forestry. The main tree species of Kavaklı which are building stands: oriental beech, fir, oaks, black pine, scots pine, oriental hornbeam, silver linden, ash, hophornbeam, boxwood, maples. Kavaklı Nature Protection Zone is located in this area with the area size of 353.06 ha

## Eğriova

The total area of Eğriova forest district is 7243,9 ha of which 82,8 % is forestry. The main tree species of Eğriova, which are building stands: fir, black pine, oaks, scots pine, juniper, oriental beech, oriental hornbeam, calabrian pine.
